The Baltic 88 Opium came to Barcelona in November for refit work; the yacht was then 8 years old and in need of repair. After talks with Ponsec and MB 92 it was decided to haul the vessel at Port Forum to see the extent of the works required. Initially it was considered that a cosmetic job could be acceptable but after removal of margin boards on the decks it soon became apparent that nothing less than a total and major refit was required.

This decision was taken in mid February 2007 and contracts were soon in place for the works to be carried out. Almost the entire project was handled by Ponsec with Willium Jobse coordination the project management, contracts and liaison between local suppliers and the yacht.
